COMMUNITY GUIDELINES

Rules

1. All students and adults are responsible for the clean-up of cabins and cafeteria area.
2. All garbage produced by the group is their responsibility and must be taken off the island when they leave.
3. Access to waterfront will be available to students only when supervised by a Sea To Sky staff member.
4. Participants will follow the safety instructions of Sea To Sky.
5. Illicit drugs and alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the Island.
6. Smoking is not permitted in any building. Smoking for adults is allowed only in designated areas outdoors.
7. Boys and girls are assigned separate rooms. Adult supervision is required in each cabin.
8. A school's expectations of student behaviour also apply at Sea To Sky.
9. Any student requiring first aid attention is referred to a Sea To Sky staff member.
